FEDERAL DISASTER DECLARATION FACT SHEET

OCTOBER 14, 2020

On August 22, 2020, President Donald J. Trump granted a Major Disaster Declaration for the State of California triggering the release of Federal funds to help people and communities recover from Wildfires that occurred August 14, 2020 to September 26, 2020, with the exception of additional damage resulting from the North Complex Fire. **This disaster declaration has been amended as indicated below in bold.** Details of the disaster declaration and assistance programs are as follows:

Individual Assistance (IA):	(Assistance to individuals and households):
IA-Designated Areas:	Butte, Lake, Monterey, Napa, San Mateo, Santa Clara, Santa Cruz, Solano, Sonoma, and Yolo Counties.
Public Assistance (PA):	(Assistance for emergency work and the repair or replacement of disaster-damaged facilities):
PA-Designated Areas:	Lake, Monterey, Napa, San Mateo, Santa Cruz, Solano, Sonoma, and Yolo Counties for emergency

protective measures (Category B), including direct federal assistance, under the Public Assistance program at 75 percent federal funding.

Lake, Monterey, Napa, Santa Cruz, Solano, and Sonoma Counties for debris removal [Category A] under the Public Assistance program (already designated for Individual Assistance and assistance for emergency protective measures [Category B], including direct federal assistance under the Public Assistance program).

Butte, Plumas, and Yuba Counties for emergency protective measures (Category B), including direct federal assistance, under the Public Assistance program.

Butte County for debris removal [Category A] (already designated for emergency protective measures [Category B], including direct federal assistance, under the Public Assistance program).

San Mateo County for debris removal [Category A] and permanent work

[Categories C-G] (already designated for Individual Assistance and assistance for emergency protective measures [Category B], including direct federal assistance, under the Public Assistance program).

Monterey, Napa, Santa Cruz, Solano, and Sonoma Counties for permanent work [Categories C-G](already designated for Individual Assistance and assistance for debris removal and emergency protective measures [Categories A and B], including direct federal assistance, under the Public Assistance program).

Nevada and Santa Clara Counties for Public Assistance, including direct federal assistance.

The President has approved the cost-share adjustment of 100 percent Federal funding of Categories A and B for a continuous period of 30 days established by the state under FEMA-4558-DR; California.

Hazard Mitigation (HM):

(Assistance for actions taken to prevent or reduce long term risk to life and property from natural hazards):

HM-Designated Areas:

All areas in the State of California are eligible for assistance under the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program.

OTHER:

Additional designations may be made at a later date if requested by the State and warranted by the results of further assessments.
